Suggested we have a rota for a week or two after each course for a responsible paddler not necessarily a coach to shepherd a group of up to 5 people. Dive Club Progress, this has been on hold during lockdown. Currently it is a mess and needs a skip for starters. Need to set up a Sub committee to carry out the work requested by the committee. JS has a list of people he is contacting them in the next couple of days to form a watts app group.	JS
GO has requested that a priority should be temporary boat storage in the dive club while it is being converted. This was discussed and it was felt that until the major changes have been made it will not be safe or suitable to store boats. It is technically a building site and should be treated as such. Although this means in the short term we will lose revenue, long term it is safer.	
Discussion about access to the site. It was agreed that access should be restricted to those on the sub committee for the reasons above. The key situation need to be resolved, possibly putting a new padlock on the fence gate and only the sub committee having keys. Currently there is a boat being stored there. Much discussion about the role of the sub committee and their responsibilities. It will be the sub committees' job to bring to life the ideas of the committee and cost them before work is done.
